Oral Questions

- 76/2020 Hon. Lenora Qereqeretabua to ask the Minister for Health and Medical Services – Can the Minister inform Parliament how long it took to get the air-conditioning units at CWM Hospital operation theatres fully repaired since patients due for surgeries were turned away at least 4 times in December until mid-January this year.
- 77/2020 Hon. Dr Salik Govind to ask the Minister for Defence, National Security and Policing, Rural and Maritime Development and Disaster Management – Can the Minister explain Government’s coordination of assistance from International partners and donors for tropical cyclone Harold.
- 78/2020 Hon. Dr Ratu Atonio Lalabalavu to ask the Minister for Health and Medical Services – Can the Minister inform Parliament on strategy and plans in place to respond to the possible re-emerging of COVID-19 cases.
- 79/2020 Hon. Vijendra Prakash to ask the Minister for Infrastructure, Meteorological Services, Lands and Mineral Resources – With Geospatial Information and its technologies becoming more recognised as a tool for substantial development, can the Minister

update Parliament on how did the Ministry contribute towards the COVID-19 pandemic and tropical cyclone Harold.
