- 155/2021 Hon. Sanjay Kirpal to ask the Minister for Defence, National Security and Policing, Rural and Maritime Development and Disaster Management – Can the Minister inform Parliament of the measures taken by the Fiji Police Force to maintain its routine operations whilst handling COVID-19.
- 156/2021 Hon. Ro Filipe Tuisawau to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Civil Service and Communications – Can the Minister update Parliament on the details regarding aircraft leased by Fiji Airways including loans and lease payments.
