### Oral Questions

- 207/2025 Hon. Iliesa Vanawalu to ask the Minister for Finance, Commerce and Business Development – Can the Minister update Parliament on Fiji’s engagement with the World Bank to advance development agenda and regional priorities within the World Bank Group’s strategic initiatives.
- 208/2025 Hon. Hem Chand to ask the Minister for Education – Can the Minister inform Parliament on the Ministry’s plans to upskill secondary school teacher graduates teaching in primary schools.
