Hon. Vijay Nath to ask the Minister for Public Works, Meteorological Services and Transport – Can the Minister inform Parliament of the total infrastructure budget allocated over the past three years, what percentage of projects were delivered on time and within budget.

Mr Speaker, please find below are the details of the Ministry Capital budget approved against budget utilisation rate from the last three financial year. This also includes our Corporate Statutory Authorities.

<u>Years</u>	<u>Approved Budget</u>	<u>Utilisation Rate Delivered on Time</u>
<u>2022-2023</u>	<u>\$344m</u>	<u>82%</u>
<u>2023-2024</u>	<u>\$511m</u>	<u>98%</u>
<u>2024-2025</u>	<u>\$458m</u>	<u>90%</u>

Those projects were not delivered on time was due to external and environment factors, procurement and contracting delays, regulatory and approval delays and some design changes and scope variations.
